Minutes: Martinez made a motion to approve the November 13, 2020 Minutes. Alter Second. Motion Pass.

KCDD Policy: KCDD supports these values while honoring the values of Respect, Innovation, Accountability, Transparency, and Partnerships. **Need to update to new values (also include Mission/Vision)**

Policy Position:

The Kansas Council on Developmental Disabilities supports the concepts of:

- Supporting people in their home communities with the resources **(resources and coordinated care)** needed to live self-defined successful lives.



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- Supporting our youth with IDD through community and education supports to individuals, families, and professionals.
- Utilizing current research, technology and resources needed to be disseminated and (change exploited to “leveraged”) exploited to support people in the community.
- Ensuring rates are adequate so that workers who provide direct (remove “direct”) supports to people with disabilities are well trained and paid a living wage with benefits.
- A KanCare implementation that represents a fair system of supports and the establishment of effective oversight and measures to protect people’s current and future access to services. (A KanCare System that represents person-centered planning with equitable access to supports, effective oversight and measures to protect an individual’s current and future access to services.)
- Supporting the continued movement to fully implement the Employment First Initiative and maximize the use of Federal Vocational Rehabilitation funding.
- Providing a rate structure that incentivizes the provision of integrated competitive (remove “the provision of”) employment.
- Reducing or eliminating the use of restraint and seclusion in all settings.
- The redirecting of resources to increase the community’s capacity to support all people including those with challenging/significant medical and behavioral support needs. (“medical, physical, and behavioral”)
- Maintaining a strong focus on DD Act values and insure KCDD is fully involved as we implement new federal and state systems changes including but not limited to: Able Act, IRS Rulings, Mental Health Issues, Every Student Succeeds Act, Joey’s Law, and Supporting Inclusive Education and Supported Decision Making. (ensure, not insure); replace “Every Student Succeeds Act with Perkins Act”)
- Support models of Medicaid/Managed Care delivery that produces outcomes that lead to improved services for people with I/DD and their families.
